

RECYCLING AT VENICE CENTRE – TO ALL OWNERS AND RESIDENTS

We have recently had issues with the City rejecting our recycling!! This is to clarify what can and can't be recycled. Please be aware that we are all expected to follow the waste management requirements. THE CITY IS NOW DOING **“SINGLE STREAM” RECYCLING**. EVEN THOUGH WE DON'T HAVE THE NEW SINGLE STREAM BINS, YOU MAY USE THE BLUE AND BEIGE BINS FOR **ALL RECYCLABLE MATERIALS** :

- ✓ **Aluminum and Steel Cans**
- ✓ **Food and Beverage Cartons**
- ✓ **Glass Bottles and Jars**
- ✓ **Mixed Paper, Newspaper and Magazines (no pizza boxes)**
- ✓ **Plastic Bottles and Containers (#1 and #2)**

Please empty, rinse and replace caps on containers. Place in containers **UNBAGGED**. DO NOT USE SINGLE USE PLASTIC BAGS FOR RECYCLABLES – NO CITY RECYCLING FOR THEM.

Large cardboard boxes should be flattened and placed in the large receptacle just outside the trash dumpster fence.

DO NOT PUT IN BLUE AND BEIGE RECYCLING BINS (NOT RECYCLED):

- x **Plastic Bags, Wrapping, Produce Bags & Containers, etc.**
- x **Styrofoam**
- x **Tanglers (Hoses, wires, chains, etc.)**
- x **Electronics**

ITEMS NOT RECYCLABLE SHOULD BE PLACED IN THE TRASH DUMPSTER.

Note that things like construction and yard debris are handled separately.

Also please be aware that plastic wrapping used to package water bottles, napkins, paper towels, toilet paper, etc., is NOT being collected by the City at this time, and should be brought instead to local retailers such as Publix for recycling. Publix also accepts: overwrap from shipping cases; Ziploc and other resealable bags (without the zipper); bread, produce and cereal bags; dry cleaning bags; newspaper sleeves; single-use plastic bags; clean and dry cling wrap; #4 and #5 plastics; and Styrofoam egg cartons.

Clean, dry Styrofoam packing peanuts may be bagged and brought to shipping outlets such as UPS for recycling.
